Dear West Coast Members & supporters,

This 2013 West Coast Challenge has attracted nearly 500 swimmers from 26 metropolitan and regional clubs to compete in what is going to be an exciting team event.

The Club apologises for any inconvenience or disappointment caused as a result of late-entry request being declined, but the need to comply with both Swimming WA and VenuesWest timeline requirements took precedence. A number of initiatives have been implemented in an attempt to keep the meet timeline as short as possible. This included removing ALL West Coast members from the 400m Free & IM as well as 800m Free.

In a further attempt to finish the meet in as timely a manner as possible, warm-ups for 800m swimmers will now commence at 7:30am in the main pool with the first of several 800m freestyle heats running between 8am & 9am. All 800m swimmers are expected to provide at least one timekeeper each, to be seated by 7:55am.

There will be no other changes to the published meet order. The front doors open at 7am and the dive pool will be available for warm-ups from 8am. 'Event 2' should get underway around the original meet start time of 9am and we are hoping to conclude the meet around 6:30pm.

Further information such as 'individual entry' confirmations and club 'timekeeping rosters' accompany this notice. No further correspondence will be entertained in regard to meet entries. We hope you enjoy the day.
