**Re: Bringing alcohol onto VenuesWest facilities**


Dear users of Arena Joondalup,

We have recently run into some issues with users bringing alcohol onto the premises at Arena Joondalup, for consumption during sports training & competition. This is in serious breach of our Liquor License and can have severe consequences for both the venue as a whole, along with individual staff members working on the day whom are at risk of receiving personal fines.

We have advised all users of these terms previously, and this has been ignored by various members. As such, we will be bringing into play a 12 month ban, for any club or association, where individuals are caught bringing alcohol, and/or consuming alcohol, on the premise, including in the car park. It is up to the clubs and associations to ensure that their members are doing the right thing by the venue.

To those who consistently follow the rules, & work together with VenuesWest to ensure a safe environment is provided to all of our users – we want to thank you for your continued support. It is an absolute pleasure working with you and we value the opportunity to be able to improve and promote community and elite sport & activities in the area.
