Announced on: Saturday 24th May 2014

Nominations for the Swimming WA Hall of Fame will be available in three different categories:

1. Athlete 2. Coach 3. Official

Nominees for the Hall of Fame will be considered only once annually with recipients of the honour being inducted at the annual Swimmer of the Year Awards.

Nominees may only be inducted in one category; however evidence supporting other categories may be submitted for consideration with the application.

The nominee must have been involved in Swimming WA for a period of years.

The nominee will only be considered based upon achievements made whilst a member of Swimming WA.

A maximum of ten attachments may be included with the nomination.

Nominations may be made by the following:

1. Affiliated Clubs and Members
2. Board and Staff of Swimming WA
3. Past Swimming WA (WASA) Members
4. Family members (in the case of deceased nominees only)

Athlete Members Criteria

Nominees must:

- a. Be an Australian citizen
- b. Be superior achievers at the highest level of competition
- c. Have the support of their peers (see section 4 and 5 of nomination form)



2014 SWIMMER OF THE YEAR AWARDS



Nominees shall not be considered until after a two year period:

- a. From which they have retired from an elite level of competition
- b. Unless the performance of an outstanding athletic achievement warrants an exception to the retirement rule

Coach Members Criteria

Nominees must:

- a. Be an Australian citizen
- b. Have made a significant contribution at a national or international level
- c. Have the support of their athletes (see section 4 and 5 of nomination form)

Nominees shall not be considered until:

- a. They have been involved in coaching for a minimum of 10 years
- b. They have been coaching as an affiliated member of Swimming WA for a minimum of 2 years

Official Members Criteria

Nominees must:

- a. Be an Australian citizen
- b. Have made a significant contribution at a national or international level

Nominees shall not be considered until:

- a. They have been a swimming official for a minimum of 10 years
- b. They have been a Swimming WA official for a minimum of 8 years

The following will be taken into consideration when voting takes place:

Nomination should be based upon the national and international implications of the nominee's achievements.

The significance of their State, National and International competing history eg. Olympic Games, Commonwealth Games, World Championships and National level competition (or in the case of coaches the number of their athletes; and officials the number of international events officiating).

World, Olympic, Commonwealth, Australian and West Australian Records will be taken into account.
