#### **About Us**

Arena Swim Club Inc. is a swimming club that provides elite coaching, training and competitive swimming for swimmers of all levels in a friendly, inclusive and supportive environment based in the Northern suburbs of Perth. The club is run by a volunteer committee and a coaching team led by head coach Simon Redmond.

The committee consists of President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Registrar and 4 additional committee members whose duties include: squad coordinator, social coordinator, uniform coordinator, newsletter coordinator. The club has a strong social media presence via website, Instagram and Facebook. These outlets allow the club to disseminate information to our members on a timely basis.

The club's AGM is generally held in November whereby committee nominations and elections are held together with club captain selection and honouring any potential life members. The club hosts several social functions throughout the year for its members.

The club has a strong sense of community and prides itself in supporting swimmers of all ages to achieve their potential. Arena Swim Club has achieved outstanding success with a strong representation of swimmers of all ages competing at State and Age/Open National level consistently. The club currently competes in A division of the SWA club championships and trains from HBF Arena in Joondalup.
